**Best answer:**

In a shallow bowl or pie plate, combine 2 eggs with about 3 tablespoons milk. Sprinkle on about 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon until the eggs are broken and one color (don't overbeat). Dip 2-3 slices of bread in, transferring it to a saucer as you go. (You can add more cinnamon for the 2nd dipping) Melt butter in a large frying pan and add the bread. You can cut the bread in half, it makes it easier to fry. Flip when golden on one side and cook the other side. Serve with maple syrup and bacon!!

Like most things, you have to get the hang of making this. If you soak the first piece of bread too much, you will run out of egg. That's why I transfer it to a plate and then flip the stack over and let it soak a bit before frying. Real butter and real maple syrup is my key to success.
